Play Ground structure – climbing frame and assault course	£ 5394.00	Active playtimes and key skills taught by Play leaders in using the climbing frame and assault course appropriately. Children have clear understanding of safety, team games, and learn range of skills when using such equipment.
Safety Surface	£2460.00	Soft surface allows children to practice acrobatic skills in a safe manner supervised guided by qualified sports leaders,
Nexus – SEND bikes	£139.00	Children with coordination and balance problems develop good gross motor skills through daily training on specialist bikes.
Pro Active – Sports coaching	£1082.00	Children take part in daily high quality multi skills activities led by sports coaches which in turn impact on concentration and behaviour in afternoon lessons. After school clubs provide children with sports enrichment opportunities which lead to inter and intra sports competitions.
